- Had a **Heart Attack** or **Stroke** in the past six months
- Have an Artificial Heart Valve or Heart Defibrillator
- May be Pregnant

Clear Liquids Diet

- Clear fruit juices, white grape juice and apple juice
- Kool-Aid or PowerAde
- Clear soup, broth or bouillon
- Water, tea or coffee without cream
- Hard candies
- Soda pop
- Jell-O or popsicles
- Nothing red or purple
- Nothing alcoholic
